life my whole land and all other Appurtenances debts and lands and after her decease
all to be sold the one half to be at her disposal and the other half to be equally divided
amongst my brother Nathaniel Morris's Children, to wit, Henry, George, Rodman
Anne, Sarah, ^{Effie} Children of the said Deceased Morris, I do hereby constitute &
appoint my trusty and well beloved friends Charles Cobbs, John Hicks and Thomas
Allen Executors of this my last will and Testament and do revoke all other Wills
or wills and do constitute and appoint this my last will and Testament made the
Tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred eighty one

At a Court held for Charlotte County the 3rd day of January 1791

This last will and Testament of Arthur Allen was presented in Court by Thomas Allen and John Wye two of the Executors therein named and the said Thomas Allen renounced in Court the benefit of Examination of the said Will and the same was proved by the oath of William Rusk & the said Thomas Allen and ordered to be recorded. On the motion of the said Executors who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat of the said Will by giving security; whereupon he with William Allen Hall & John Hammett his Executors entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose reserving liberty to Charles Cobb the other Executor to join in the probat thereof when he shall think fit
