Fourthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Chandler two
pounds eight shillings good and lawful money of Virginia which I
leave for her in the care of my executors to be hers and her heirs forever.
Fifthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Senoak, two pounds
eight shillings good and lawful money of Virginia, which I leave for
her in the care of my executors to be hers and her heirs forever. Sixthly

fourth I give and bequeath my good and lawful money of Virginia which I
leave for her in the care of my executors to be hers and her heirs forever.
Fifthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Senock, two pounds
eight Shillings good and lawful money of Virginia, which I leave for
her in the care of my executors to be hers and her heirs forever. Sixthly
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Judith Toney five Shillings good
and lawful money of Virginia, which I leave in the care of my
Executors for her. to be hers & her heirs forever. And also I constitute
make and ordain, James Barnes and Francis Barnes my two sons, sole Executors
to this my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby utterly disavow
revoke and Disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills & gives
bequests and executors by me in any ways before named, made and bequeathed
ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.
