Cattle and crops with all the property I possess except what I have already given to my sister Jude
in this will I desire may be sold and after paying all my just debts the money arising
therefrom shall be equally divided between my Brothers and Sisters viz Jesse Beatty Sarah
Benjamin & William. It is also my will and desire that Daniel Wilks and Jesse Wilks
should have the above will executed October 25 1792

This last Will and Testament of Minor Wilks. dec. was presented in Court by Daniel Wilks one of
the Executors therein named and the same was proved by the oath of George Lynn and Elizabeth Wilks
and ordered to be Recorded. On the motion of the said Geo. Lynn who made oath according to Law certificate is
granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form he giving Security whereupon he together
with George Jesse his Secularly interest into and acknowledge their bond according to Law for that
purpose reserving liberty to Jesse Wilks the other Executor to join on the probate thereof when he shall think
fit
