 one cow and calf one sow and piggs and two ewes and Lambs and five hundred pounds
 cash to be paid as soon as possible it could be raised to him and his heirs forever. I Item
 I give to my son Peter Cardwell one feather Bed and furniture one cow and calf one sow
 and piggs and two ewes and Lambs like wise after the death of my wife Susanna Cardwell
 the Land and Plantation whereon I now live, to him and his heirs forever. I Item I give
 to my Daughter Maryam Cardwell one feather bed and furniture one cow and calf
 one sow and piggs and two ewes and Lambs one young Mare or horse Saddle and and bridle
 to her and her heirs forever. I Item to my beloved wife Susanna Cardwell all the remainder
 that my Estate not willed, to her During her Natural life: without any Interruption: my
 will and desire is That after the death of my wife, the Estate lent to her shall be Equally
 divided amongst all my sons and Daughters to them and their heirs forever. It shall be
