I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Catherine Tugua the following Slaves to wit  
John, Will, Nancy, Sam, & old Sam, to be hers & her heirs forever. Also I give &  
bequeath to my beloved Daughter Nancy Tugua, Tom, Emy, Sonny, Abram, & Will, to be  
hers & her heirs forever. Also I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Francis Tugua  
the following Slaves to wit, - Obey, Doll, Mary, Isaac, & Squier to be hers & her heirs forever.  
Also I give and bequeath to my beloved son Samuel Tugua the following Slaves (viz) Tom, Kate,
