Also I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Catherine Tugua the following Slaves to wit John, Will, Nance, Sam, & old Sam, to be hers & her heirs forever. Also I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary Tugua, Sam, Emy, Jerry, Abram, & Will, to be hers & her heirs forever. Also I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Francis Tugua the following Slaves to wit, - Obey, Doll, Mary, Isaac, & Squire to be hers & her heirs forever. Also I give and bequeath to my beloved son Samuel Tugua the following Slaves (viz) Tom, Kate, Morris, Ben, and a boy named together with a Tract of Land Bounded as following, beginning at Stanton above at the mouth of Wolf Trap, and continues to the head of Wolf Trap, at Joseph Tugua's line, continues Coles Ferry Road, to 5th Wards Road, and down 5th Wards Road, until it joins Steeles line, Steeles line continues to the edge of the low ground upon Stanton, and from thence a direct line to the River.
