In the name of God amen I Sarah Scott of Charlotte County Virginia being of sound memory and discretion, do ord^{de clare} and this to be my last Will & Testament After the payment of all my just debts, which I do hereby direct my executors to discharge. I give and bequeath unto my son Clement Read a negro woman called Betty and her youngest child John to him and to his heirs forever. I give to my daughter Prescilla Scott my carriage and harness to her & her heirs forever. To my sons Henry & and William Scott I give a negro woman called Cato & her two children James and Essex five head of horses vizt. my two carriage horses a black mare a horse called Pilgrims & a white colt, four beds of furniture four bedsteads, one looking glass and dressing table, two cases bottles, one or cart on my plantation Warfield and all the utensils on said plantation. I give them all unto them & their heirs forever.

tables to them and their heirs forever. I give to my Grand daughter Sarah Read
a bay colt in saddle and bridle. To my Grandson Isaac Read I give one bay
Colt. I give to my grand daughter Catharine Scott one bed and furniture.
To my son Isaac Read I will Dick Sterling, two horses viz the Tell mare
and Swift three bees and furniture. Three bedsteads, Eighteen head of
cattle, half the stock of hogs now on the plantation all my kitchen furni-
ture, twelve rush bottom chairs, one Folding table, one dressing table
and glass all my table linen, and other table furniture, one Suite
of Castles two large trunks, and all the rest of my property of what-
soever kind not ^{before} devised to him and his heirs forever. My Will and
desire is that my negro man Sam should have his freedom. I
appoint my sons Remond and Isaac Read Executors to this my Will
and Testament. I do hereby revoke the gift of Betty's youngest child to
my son Remond, and give the said child to Catharine Scott my Grand-
daughter. Signed this 27th day of May 1802.

oath according to Law for that purpose. Reserving liberty to the other
executor named in the said Will to join in the probate thereof when
he shall think fit.
