and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form
following revoking all former wills. In the first place I give & bequeath
unto my Son William Rice one Negro woman named Sarah & her
increase to him & to his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto
my Son Samuel Rice one Negro man named Ben, unto him &
& to his heirs forever. Also three hundred acres of Land in the State
of Kentucky, he having it on his Power to lay off the same
in any way or manner he may think proper from any Tract or Tracts
Land which is or hereafter shall be possessed in the said State of
Kentucky which I give to him & to his heirs forever. And as to the
remainder of my Lands in the State of Kentucky my Will & Desire
is that whole of them be equally divided between my daughters
Bridget Cardwell wife of John Cardwell and Elizabeth Rice which
said Lands so divided I give to them and to their heirs forever.
Item I give and bequeath unto my Son David Rice one negro named
Anthony to him and to his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Celia Cardwell wife of John Cardwell one Negro
Woman named Frank and her increase to her and to her heirs forever

unto my Daughter Celia (and wife of John Cardwell) one negro
Woman Named Frank and her increase to her and to her heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Esther Pamplin wife
of Henry Pamplin one negro man named Moses, to her & to her
heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Rice
two negro girls named Hannah, and Milly & their increase, One Bay
Mare & Colt & one feather Bed & furniture to her other heirs forever
I send unto my daughter Rebecca White wife of Joseph White one negro
Boy named Hal during her life & after her death, I give the said
Boy Hal unto my Grand daughter Elizabeth Cardwell to her & to her
heirs forever. My will & desire is that residue of my Estate both
real and personal be sold by my executors and my just Debts being
paid out of the money arising from such sale, Then I give first one
hundred and twenty five pounds out of the remainder unto my
daughter Elaney Rice to be placed in the hands of my son named
Rice for her support & maintenance and after her death I give
the said one hundred & twenty five pounds unto my said son named
Rice for his trouble & care of my said Daughter Elaney My further
desire is that the surplus of the money if any, arising from the

Mare & Cott & one feather Bed & furniture to her other heirs forever
I lend unto my daughter Rebecca White wife of Joseph White one negro
Boy named Hal during her life & after her death, I give the said
Boy Hal unto my Grand daughter Elizabeth Cardwell to her & to her
heirs forever. My will & desire is that residue of my Estate both
real and personal be sold by my executors and my just Debts being
paid out of the money arising from such sale, Then I give first one
hundred and twenty five pounds out of the remainder unto my
daughter Charity Rice to be placed in the hands of my son Samuel
Rice for her support & maintenance and after her death I give
the said one hundred & twenty five pounds unto my said son Samuel
Rice for his trouble & care of my said Daughter Charity. My further
desire is that the surplus of the money, if any, arising from the
sale of the residue of my Estate not specifically devised should be
equally divided between my following children, (to wit) William
Rice, Samuel Rice, David Rice, Collie Cardwell, Esther
Pumpkin and Elizabeth Rice, which I give to each of them —

and their inscription here forever. Lastly I do appoint my friends Richard
James & and my sons William Rice, & Samuel Rice Executors of this my
last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
