Calling to mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that is appointed for all men
once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament; that is to say principally
I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave
it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial
at the discretion of my executors, nothing doubting but at the General resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such
worldly estate wherewith I am blessed God to bestow on me in this life I give

and as soon as in the following manner I gave - (witness that my whole estate
real & personal be all kept together until the death of my loving wife Rachel Holt &
at her death to be sold to the highest Bidder at the direction of my three sons
Dudley Holt, Woodley Holt & Thomas Holt, or any two of them whom I appoint
my executors and the money thence arising to be equally Divided amongst my
nine Children (viz) three sons and six Daughters (to wit) Dudley, Woodley, Thomas
Holt, Mary Jones, Amey Jones, Elizabeth Jones, Martha Holt, Dolly Holt Hannah
Holt and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other
former Testaments, Wills, bequests, Executors by me in any ways before named -
