do hereby make in body, but of sound mind, do constitute this my last Will and testament
First I recommend my soul & body to God who created them, humbly trusting that although
death may separate them now they may one day be reunited a glorious body to die no
more, then the mercy of God and merits of my dear Redeemer. Also my desire is that
all my just debts, & funeral expenses be first paid by my executors hereafter named, Also my will
& desire is that my executors hereafter named be vested with full power and authority to
to dispose of any part of my Estate either Real or Personal & to turn & convert it to such
uses as will be most advantageous to my wife & Children. Also it is my will and
desire that my wife Susannah Hunt should during the infancy of my sons or until
my daughter arrives at the age of sixteen years, or until either of my Children
marry, and during her widowhood continue in the possession and receive
the profits of the whole of my estate both real & personal for the support & purchase
of her own Comfort and Support, and the maintenance & education of my
Children. But should my beloved wife marry before my Children arrive
at the respective ages aforesaid or before the marriage of either of them, I then
give her one third of the whole of my estate both real & personal to dispose of as

give as she pleases to any of her son or grand children - However it is my wish
that any thing in the foregoing clause should not diminish the power already
given my executors hereafter to be named. Also it is my will and sense that as my
son arrives at the age of barely one year or my daughter at eighteen or as they marry
my executors shall to them, at their discretion any equal share of my estate, after my
Wife has received her one third part already devised, which I give to them & their
heirs forever. Also it is my will & sense that the Child or Children of which my Wife
is now pregnant should on its or their birth be entitled to an equal part of my estate
with my Children now born, subject to the same restrictions, and to be allotted in the
same manner " " & at the same period, with respect to themselves in as much
with respect to my Children now born. Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my
beloved wife Susannah Hunt, my father in law Joel Watkins and my brothers in law
Henry A and William M Watkins, executors and administrators of this my last will
and testament, And do hereby revoke & declare all other wills heretofore made by me
