

In the Name of God Amen, I William Price Son of Charlotte Cunningham and late
of Virginia being of Sound mind and memory but being weak in body and knowing the
uncertainty of this life do make and Publish this my last will and Testament in manner
following hereby Revoking and making Void all former and other wills by me made and
first I order and desire that after my decease, my just debts may be paid and discharged and
that that there be raised out of my estate a sufficient sum for that purpose, according to the
Judgment and discretion of my executors, I give and devise to my son Daniel Price his
heirs and assigns forever that tract or parcel of Land which he now occupies and enjoys
with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, I give and devise unto my son Samuel
Price his heirs and assigns forever, one tract or parcel of Land bounded by the lands of
my son Williamson, Paschal Greenhill, & Hands Fork Creek containing four hundred and
seventy four Acres, be the same more or less. I bequath to my son Samuel, two negroes called
Dick and Stephen, one waggon and Team of Horses. I give and bequath to my Daughter
Nancy one Horse and Saddle of the Value of eighteen pounds. I give and Bequath to
my Daughter Polly one horse and Saddle of the Value of eighteen pounds, two cows and
two calves and one feather Bed and Bed cloths to my Daughter Sarah one horse and
Saddle of the Value of eighteen pounds two cows and calves & one feather Bed and Bed
cloths to my Daughter Lucy I give & bequath one horse & Saddle of the Value of eighteen
pounds, two cows and two calves & one feather Bed and Bed cloths, I give and Bequath

cloths to my Daughter Lucy I give & bequath one horse & Saddle of the Value of eighteen
pounds, two cows and two calves & one feather Bed and Bed cloths, I give and Bequath
unto my Daughter Elizabeth my son William and my son Williamson twenty shillings
each I give and Bequath to my beloved wife Mary Price for and During her natural life
the dwelling house and land which I now possess, and after her decease to my son Williamson & his
heirs, also to my said wife I give three negroes, named Sam, Will, and Luce together with the
House hold furniture. During her natural life, which three last mento & Virginia after
my wifes death together with the rest of my Slaves, I do hereby give and bequath to my
aforesaid three Daughters Polly, Sarah and Lucy, Share and Share, alike upon the days
or times they severally come of the age of twenty one years, or the days of their marriage which
ever shall soonest happen, all the rest of my Estate (Viz) Horses cows Hogs Sheep
Household furniture and implements of Husbandry I give to my son Samuel after
the decease of my said wife, my Exors, do make and Execute a sufficient and Legal right
or rights to Mr Brinn Alday of a Tract of Land upon Cub Creek contg. five hundred
acres, be the same more or less which I have Exchanged with him for the lands in my son
Williams Possession and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my wife Mary
Price & my sons William Price Williamson Price Daniel Price & Samuel Price exors
of this my last will & Testament, this 30th day of August in the year of our Lord 1791

Household furniture and implements of Housewifery I give to my Son Samuel after
the decease of my said wife, my Exors, do make and execute a sufficient and Legal right
or rights to Mr Brin Alday of a Tract of Land upon but creek contg. five hundred
acres, be the same more or less which I have Exchanged with him for the lands in my Son
Williams Possession and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my wife Mary
Price & my Sons William Price Williamson Price Daniel Price & Samuel Price exors
of this my last will & Testament, this 30th day of August in the year of our Lord 1791

John Hannah two of the Witnesses subscribed and ordered to be recorded and at a Court held for the said County the 7 day of October following on the motion of William Price the aforesaid exors was made oath according to law. certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form he giving security whereupon he together with buttrick Williamson William Price and Mathew White his securitys entered into and acknowledged their bond according to law for that purpose the said Williamson Price having first renounced in open Court the burthen of execution of the said Will reserving Liberty to the other exors herein named to join in the probate thereof when they shall think fit Teste Thomas Read C.
