my last will and testament, to wit, I give and bequeath to my son Redmond
Redmond all that part of the Tract of Land wherein I live, which lies on the
South side of the branch which heads near Randolph's old Road, and makes
into the Horse pen creek, just below Joseph Collins Plantation, Beginning at
a Corner Dog Wood on May's and Joseph Collins Line on said branch thence up
the same to the head, thence a Direct Line to Cole Carringtons Line on the Top of
the Hill just above the old Fish Trap Pond in Little Roomack, thence along
Carringtons and May's line to the Beginning. To him my said son Redmond
his Heirs and Assigns forever, but in Case he my said son Redmond should
die before he comes of Age ~~whenever~~ ^{where} I give and bequeath the said Land
to my son George Redmond his Heirs and Assigns forever, Item, I ^{give} and bequeath
to my son George Redmond the following part of the Tract of Land and
Plantation wherein I live (to wit), beginning at the said Dog Wood which my
said son Redmond's Land Begins at thence along Joseph Collins and
Thomas Collins's Lines to the River in the County of Charlotte.

dividing line already mentioned between him and my other son Redmond
to the beginning to him my said son George Redmond his heirs and assigns
forever, & in case my said son George should die without heirs before he
comes of age, I give and bequeath the said Land to my Daughter Melley
Redmond her heirs and assigns forever. Then, I give and bequeath all the
Residue of my Tract of Land to my Daughter Melley Redmond and her
heirs forever also two cows and calves (already in her possession) but in
case she my said Daughter Melley should die without heirs, I give and bequeath
the said Land willed her to my son George Redmond his heirs and assigns
forever. Then after my lawful Debts are discharged I give and bequeath
all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided amongst all my Children
or their legal Representatives. Then, I constitute my son Thomas Redmond
and Thomas Collar Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby Resolving
all Affairs with my own men In things whereof I have heretofore taken
hand and Seal this first day of May A.D. 1700 and our hundredth thirty
year.

The within written Last Will and Testament of William Redmond deceased in bearing Thomas Redmond and Thomas Collier the Executors therein named and the same was proved by the Oaths of John Collier, Joseph Collier, and Francis Collier and Ordered to be Recorded, And on the Motion of the said Executors who made Oath according to Law, Certificate is Granted them for Obtaining a Probate of the said Will, in due form, they giving Security, whereupon they together with Paul Farrington their security, interred into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose. —
