1780 } in the year Seventeen hundred and eighty I William Sublett of Charlotte County  
in the Colony of Virginia Being weak and afflicted in body but thanks be to God in perfect  
Sence and Memory doe Make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say  
first I give my Soul to God who gave it hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ he will  
accept it as holy and without blame, before him in love and my body I leave to the earth  
from whence it came, and as touching what Worldly Estate it has pleased God to bestow  
on me I the quoth devise and dispose of as Follows, and first I lend and Bequeath to my beloved  
Wife Susanmar Sublett all the Living that I now am possessed of during her Life after  
her decease I order that Land & negroes with whatsoever there may remain immediately  
Sold and the money Equally divided amongst the Children I then do hereby constitute and  
appoint John White Samuel White and my Wife Susanmar Sublett the sole Executors  
of this my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and Seal the day and year first above mentioned. William Sublett L S

Court by John White, Samuel White and Susannah Sublet the Executors and Executrix  
herein named, and the same was proved by the Oaths of John Weatherford and John Holland  
two of the Witnesses thereto Subscribed, and ordered to be Recorded, on their motion of the said  
Executrix who made Oath according to Law Certificate is Granted her for obtaining a probate  
of the said Will in due form She giving Security Whereupon She together with Charles M<sup>r</sup> Henry  
and John Wheeler her Security entered into and Acknowledged their bond for that purpose  
and John White and Samuel White the Executors Renounced in open Court the Execution  
of the said Will.
