

W. Sublett In The Name of God I now the 13th day of March
A.D. 1780. Make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament, That is to say
in the year seventeen hundred and eighty three Million Sublett of Charlotte County
in the Colony of Virginia Being weak and affected in body but thanks be to God am perfid
Inse and Memory doe Make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament, That is to say
first I give my Soul to God who gave it hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ he will
accept it as holy and without Blame, before him in love and my body I leave to the earth
from whence it came, and as touching what Worldly Estate it has pleased God to bestow
on me I bequeath devise and dispose of as follows, and first I bind and Bequeath to my beloved
wife Swanner Sublett all the living that I now am possessed of during her life after
her decease I order that Lands negroes with whatsoever there may remaine be immediately
Sold and the money equally divided amongst the Children Item I do hereby constitute and
appoint John White Samuel White and my wife Swanner Sublett the sole Executrix
of this my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal the day and year first above mentioned. William Sublett L.S.

A Court held for Charlotte County the 7th day of August 1700
The within written Last Will and Testament of William Sublett Esq was exhibited in
Court by John White, Samuel White and Susannah Sublett the Executors and Executrix
therein named, and the same was proved by the Oaths of John Weatherford and John Holland
two of the witnesses thereto subscribed, and ordered to be Recorded, on the motion of the said
Executor who made Oath according to Law certificate is Granted her for obtaining a probate
of the said Will in due form & giving Security whereupon she together with Charles McLean
and John Wheeler her security entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose
and John White and Samuel White the Executors renounced in open Court the Execution
of the said Will.
