I William Williams of Charlotte County being in my perfect Senses and Memory do
make this my last Will, Revoking all former wills in the manner and form as follows
viz. I bequeath to my well beloved wife during her life, three Nigros Sam
Bright and Tanny and the other two Nigros hereafter mentioned which I will be my
own sons John and William a Nigro man Named Joshua, and a Nigro man Named
Jimmy to be continued with my wife until the heirs arrive to the age of Twenty one
and also the land and plantation wherein I now live also all the personal part
of my Estate except one bed and furniture and two cows which I give to my Daughter
Elizabeth Williams, I give and bequeath to my son John Williams a Nigro man
Named Joshua to him and his heirs for ever, also I give him a black horse both
like and I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Williams a Nigro girl
Named Tanny to her and her heirs for ever, also I give and bequeath to William
Williams my second son a Nigro man Named Jimmy to him and his heirs for ever
I give the land wherein I now live to my two sons William Williams and Pugh Williams
to be equally divided between ^{them} when my son Pugh comes of age to them and their heirs
for ever, also I give and bequeath to my son Pugh Williams a Nigro man Named Sam
to him and his heirs for ever, I give and bequeath to my three youngest Daughters
Elizabeth Williams, Tabby Williams, and Sally Williams a Nigro man Named
Bright and her increase to be equally divided when my youngest daughter is at
the age of Eighteen or more, If either of my children should die before marriage

William, my second son a Negro man named Jemmy to him and his heirs forever
I give the Sons whereon I have lived to my two sons William Williams and Pugh Williams
to be equally divided between ^{them} when my son Pugh comes of age to them and their heirs
forever, also I give and bequeath to my son Pugh Williams a Negro man named Sam
to him and his heirs forever, I give and bequeath to my three youngest Daughters
Elizabeth Williams, Tabby Williams, and Sally Williams a Negro man named
Brizget and her increase to be equally divided when my youngest daughter is at
the age of Eighteen or more years, If either of my children should die before marriage
or comes of age their Estate to be equally divided between my three youngest
Daughters, I do appoint Pugh Price, William Martin, and Michael Williams
to be Executors of this my last Will, In Witness whereof I have put my hand and
seal this 23^d day of March 1775. ^{his mark} William X Williams L.S.

At a Court held for the County the fourth day of September 1775.

The within written last Will and Testament of William Williams deceased, exhibited
in Court by Pugh Price one of the Executors of the said William, the Executors being
named and the same were proved by the oaths of James Boulton and Mary Farrington
one of the within five lawful subscribers to the said Will of the said William Williams
and were to be Received on the return of the said Executors and Executors who were



each according to the power of the said Will is granted them they giving security
whereupon they together with Charles Livingston and James Adams their Secretaries entered
into and subscribed their bond according to law for that purpose necessary to bind
to William Morton the other Exécutor to join in the execution of the said Will when
he shall think fit
