on of and from the sd Phillip Ellyott his self & assigns &
all & only other person or persons whom it shall or may concern
all such sum & sums of money as are due or owing for
by him the sd Phillip Ellyott to me & by virtue of the sd
written obligations and either of them, the aforesaid full
power & right is power of our doct of Shire but &
adventured with him the sd Phillip Ellyott by writing
ship and voyage aforesaid as by a note under the hand of
him the sd Phillip Ellyott duly apper. And for the sd Rogers
witnessed & approved. Walter de Thorsby given & granted to be
my sd attorn full power good right & lawfull authority
in the shire the sd Phillip Ellyott his self & assigns &
all & only the sd person & persons concerned in the shire
as his & their goods monies wares or merchandise to be arre. &
attare impland condempned & impson them from & only
of them his self & only of the sd goods monies wares
& merchandise or again to release discharge & out of prison
acquittance or other lawfull assuage for my goods or deeds
to make & execute with his will attorn or attorney or one
or more under him any sd attorn to make & substitute &
at the like his pleasure for same again to make & buy &
wells, and further to make such composition & generally
to do & execute all & only such other act & things touching &
as to my sd attorn shall seeme fit & needfull to be done in or
about the shire. Hence promising to ratify confirm &
allow all & what good my sd attorn shall lawfully do or cause
or cause to be done in the shire by virtue of these presents.
