And now for yo setting of my estate, I doe order give & dispose the same in manner & forme (vint) I appointe ordaine & constitute my well beloved wife Elizabeth Jones to be my whole & sole Exor.^r to pay these legacies yf I shall bequeath.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Jones one feather bed with all yo furniture belonging to a bed, & fower covers with their female increase, the scales to them that keep them, Also I give her one mare with her female increase likewise two silver spoones & fower powder dishes as my wife shall thinke fitt.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Paul Jones one feather bed with all yo furniture belonging to a bed, also I give him fower covers with their female increase, one mare with her female increase, two guns & two silver spoones, & one plain gold ring

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Jones one feather bed with all yo furniture belonging to a bed two covers with y^r female increase, also two silver spoones, one mare with her female increase, & two guns.

And if it should please God to take any of these my children my daughter or either of my sons, It is my will that these my legacies shall be equally divided to the survivors or survivor.

Item I give & bequeath unto W^m Read one fow & a gun with yo promises yf he honestly serve my wife till he comes to yo age of One & twenty, not oth^r.

and this being my last will & Testament I have sett my hand & scale this 25th of January 1688
