 by these presents have granted bargained and sold and by these presents shall
 granted bargained and sold all that four hundred and sixteen Acres of Land lying
 and being in the County abovesaid on the North side of the River bounding upon
 the Branches of the River Cross Vint One hundred and seventy six Acres granted
 unto the said Evans by Patent dated the second day of May One thousand seven
 hundred and five One hundred Acres of Land by Deed of Gift from John Rock to
 to Charles Evans and Sarah his wife bounded as per Deeds Record of Charles County
 Court and one hundred and fifty Acres which the said Evans bought of John Brown
 bounded as per Deeds of Deeds and Release dated the sixth day of July One thousand
 and seven hundred and twenty with all housing Orchards Gardens Houses and Im-
 provements except Confront Square of Land where the said Evans wife has bought and
