Item I give unto my Said Son my Gun to be delivered him at my death

Item I give unto my Lassing Daughter Susanna (Wife to Michael Sherman)
four negroes two of which are now in her possession named Deny & Henry
the other two are to be delivered to her at the finishing of the crop
named old Deny & Billie, which I four negroes I give unto my S. Daughter
Susanna & her heirs for ever
