I give and Bequeath to my Loving wife Three Negro men Named Dick Downout and Jacob, and a young boy horse Brandes H E and one double double dove

I give to my daughter Rebecca one Negro boy Named Bobb

I give to my daughter Sarah one Negro Girl Named Sue

I give to my daughter Ann one Negro girl Named Fanny

I give and Bequeath one Negro wechel Named Choll and her increase to be Equally divided betoken my two Youngest daughters Sarah and Ann when either of my said daughters come to lawfull age or Marry.

the remainder of my estate I give and bequeath to be equally divided between my wife and children and do hereby constitute and appoint my Loving wife Exec: of this my last will & Testament as witness my hand this seventeenth day of February one Thousand seven hundred and Sixty Six.

Rem: If it should please God my wife prove with child then my wife is that the said Negro wechel Named Choll and her increase be equally divided between my three daughters Rebecca Sarah & Ann when either come to lawfull age or Marryed
