that I Benjamin Willard of Westover parish and County of  
Charles City Mariner Divers good Causes & Considerations me  
hereunto moving but more especially for and in Consideration  
of the sum of one hundred pounds Current Money to me in  
hand paid by Thomas Ellerbee of the Sd. parish & County plant<sup>2</sup>

I have bargained sold aliened Lefcoed & Confirmed  
and by these presents doo Bargain sell alien Lefcoed & Confirm  
unto the Sd. Thomas Ellerbee his heirs & assigns forever a  
certain plantation or Tract of land situate lying & being  
in Westover parish in the County of Charles City aforesd.  
Containing by Estimation one hundred & forty acres  
to be the same more or less & bounded as followeth (Vis<sup>1</sup>)

Beginning at a landing place on James River thence up  
into the woods along a line of marsh trees North thirty five  
Degrees East, one hundred & sixty eight chain to a corner tree  
Thence South thirty one degrees East Sixteen & one halfe  
chain to a corner tree Thence North forty two degrees East  
Seventy four & one halfe chain to a corner tree thence  
North fifty three Degrees West forty nine & a halfe chain  
to a corner Lightwood Knoll, Thence South forty two degrees  
west Sixty two & a halfe chain to a corner tree thence South  
thirty five degrees west One hundred & Sixty eight chain  
to a corner Spar in trees on the River thence down the river  
as it windeth to the place where it first began, being the  
land formerly Conveyed by the said Thomas Ellerbee to me  
by Deed of lease & release bearing date the fifth to Sixth  
of November 1728 & the reversion & reversions remainder  
& remanders thereof & of every part or parcel thereof with
