By Virtue of an order of the Court of this County we whose Names are underwritten do meet Cap^t Thomas Chapley who was appointed by now Kent County Court & we have made agreement with Richard Spriggs, Thomas Chishell, & William Morris, to keep the great bridge over Chickahominy Swamp in repair for the term of Twenty one years now next coming for which they are to be payd one pound of Tobacco for every Parish within these two Counties yearly during 4 Continuance of 4 agreement wth Cash and Concomitancy as appears by the articles Indented & hereto annexed for 4 performance whereof we have taken bond
