I give to my Daughter Sarah one Negro Girl Named Sue
I give to my daughter Anna one Negro girl Named Fanny
I give and Bequeath one Negro wench Named Nell and her increase
to be Equally divided betwixen my two youngest daughters Sarah
and Anna when either of my Said daughters come to lawfull age
or Marry.

All the residue of my estate I give and bequeath to be equally
divided between my wife and children and do hereby constitute
and appoint my loving wife Exec of this my last will & Testam
as witness my hand this Seaventth day of February One Thousand
Seaven hundred and Twenty Six.
