of Five Shillings to him in hand paid at or before the Enrolling & Delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge as for
securing the payment of Ten Pounds Ten Shillings & Six pence lawful
money of Virginia with lawful Interest thereon, Hath granted bargained
& sold along & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell
alien & confirm, unto the said Richard Adams his heirs and assigns, one
certain Tract or parcel of Land Situate lying & being in the parish of
Westover & County of Charles City, beginning at a corner up Oak in
Secretary Carters line thence to a corner gum, thence a long lead
Fences line, to a corner pine in Samuel Jordans line thence up a run
to a corner, thence to the up Oak from whence it begun containing by
Estimate or fifty Acres more or less it being the Land whereon the said
Morgan now dwelle with all houses woods waters & whatsoever
thereon growing standing or being & thereupon & thereupon, remainder &
