wife of the said Robert Harrison cannot conveniently travel to our Court of our
said County to make the Acknowledgement of the said Conveyance Therefore
we do give unto you or any two or more of you power to receive the Acknowledgement
which the said Elizabeth shall be willing to make before you of the Conveyance
aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is herunto Annexed and we
do thereto Com mand you that you do Personally go to the said Elizabeth and
Receive her Acknowledgement of the same and Examine her Privily and apart
from her husband aforesaid whether she doth the same freely and Voluntarily
without any Persuasion or Threats and whether she be willing that the same
should be Recorded in our said County Court and when you have received her
Acknowledgement and Examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly &
Openly Certify us thereof in our said County Court under your Seals
Anding then that this Indenture herunto Annexed and this our
Witness Mordecai Debnam Clerk of our said Court the eighteenth
day of August 1768 in the eighth year of our Reign "Mordecai Debnam
