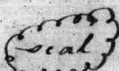
In the name of God Amen I John Major Senior of Westover

whom I constitute and appoint whole & Sole Executor of this my last
Will and Testament Revoking all other Wills by me heretofore
made as Witnesses my hand and Seal this 5th Day of April 1768

Concealing and Delivery of these presents have Granted Bargained
Conveyed Infeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents doth give
Grant Bargain, Sell, Convey Release Infeoff and Confirm unto the
Thomas Brown his heirs and assigns for ever One certain Tract
or parcel of Land containing by Estimation Two hundred Acres
