

Table, To a parcel of Pewter consisting of Dishes, Basins, Plates and other Pewter, Six Chests and two Chests of Drawers, three Tables, six Chairs, two Guns; a set of Pistols and Holsters with other furniture therewith belonging, three Scales, one wide Scale, one Cart and Horse Harness, Two Dooms and gear thereto belonging, four Spinning wheels, a parcel of Carpenters, Coopers and Shoemakers Tools, To a parcel of Cash, Tubs, Hails and other Wooden Ware, a parcel of Earthen Ware and Glass a pair of Sheelyards and two pairs of Scales, some leather and Raw Hides, one warming pan, one frying Pan a Box Iron, Spice mortar, Candle sticks and other small necessaries of Iron Ware, Axes, Hoes, Harrow teeth and old Iron, a parcel of Tobacco and sundry other necessaries.
