forever Three hundred Acres of Land the upper one of these Tracts
now live on adjoining the Land of Edward Stubblefield John
Binno and my son Alexander Walker two hundred Acres of
which Land he is to pay for at the same rate the other Land I have
not given away is sold for, which Money is to be equally divided
between my sons, Benjamin Walker, William Walker, David
Walker and my grand daughter Sarah Walker Daughter of my
son Henry Walker deceased —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Walker one
hundred Acres Land adjoining the Land I have given my son
Freeman Walker including the plantation whereon she now lives
to her and her Heirs forever, also one large black Trunk, my wearing
Apparel and one warming Pan —

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Walker one
large Bible, to him and his Heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Elizabeth
Walker daughter of my son Benjamin Walker twenty shillings
Current Money —

Item I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Walker one Book called the lock upon death to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Walker twenty shillings current money —

Item I give and bequeath to my son Freeman Walker one Copper Kettle to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Lockey Walker daughter of my son Freeman Walker twenty shillings current money —

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Elizabeth Walker daughter of Alexander Walker sen^r Twenty shillings current money —
