This Indenture made this third day of August in the thirteenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c and in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy three, Between Jeffery Gilliam of the County of Charles City of the one part and Robert Drake of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jeffery Gilliam for and in consideration of the Sum of Thirty eight pounds fifteen shillings Current Money of Virginia, to him in hand paid by the said Robert Drake at or before the envealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Gilliam doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained sold aliened released Enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien release Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Robert Drake his Heir and Assigns forever, Seventy Acres of Land be the same more or less. Situate lying and being in the County of Charles City being part of the land whereon the said Gilliam now lives bounded as follows Viz^t Beginning at a Pine, thence along the said Gilliams line North West to a large corner Pine, and thence a north course to Collins's Run, thence along the said Run to Susannah Christians line thence down
