This Indenture made the twenty seventh day of September Anno Domini one
Thousand seven hundred and sixty nine Between W^m. Tyree and John Wayles of the
Parish of Westover in Charles City County of the one part and Abram Brown of the
Parish and County aforesaid of the other part **Witnesseth** that the said W^m.
Tyree and John Wayles for and in consideration of the Sum of ninety six pounds lawful
money of Virginia paid in hand and secured to be paid by the said Abram Brown
they have bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell
Release and confirm unto the said Abram Brown for ever one tract or parcel
of land containing by Estimation one hundred and fifty Acres situate lying
and being in the County of Charles City in Parish of Westover and bounded
as follows: Beginning at a corner pine near the old tree run thence along a line of
