In the name of God amen November the 15th 1766 I Thomas Popper Planter of Charles City County being of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament first I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I commend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors and for my worldly estate I give and dispose of the same in the following Manner and for me I promise I leave in possession of Susannah my wife all my estate for and during her Natural life or Widow hood and my will is that if she should Marry again then my Estate to be Equally divided that is to say the one half to Susannah my Wife and the other half to be Equally Divided between my loving brother Joseph Popper my loving cousin Jane Edwards and in case she never Marry after her decease all to be Equally Divided between Joseph Popper & Jane Edwards I make Ordain and Appoint Susannah my wife my Executrix and Joseph Popper and W^m Edwards my Executors of this my last will & Testament my desire is that my Estate be not appraised I do hereby utterly curse and damn all and every other former will and bequest whatsoever confirming this and no other to be my last will and

Testament and according to the true meaning of the same Thomas Roper set my hand and seal the day and date first above written
