In the name of God amen I William Dancy of the County of Charles City being weak and sore of perfect mind & memory for which I am thankful to the almighty God make no doubt constitute this to be my last will and testament my soul I recommend to my Creator and trust through the mediation of my redeemer Christ to have a pardon for all my faults & attain my eternal part; I expect my Executors hereafter mentioned will have it & presently enter into my sole & sole estate. I give and dispose of it as follows to wit: First I do give that all my Just debts be paid

Item I give unto my friend William Acrell a tract of land lying on Chickahominy River containing three hundred acres be it more or less that was given me by my father Francis Dancy to him and his heirs forever. I also give unto the said William Acrell an negro boy named Sam to him & his heirs forever

Item I give unto John Colgin a black mare which I purchased of Littlebury Harveymen's estate

Item I give and bequeath to my friend Freeman Walker of Sachville Diener each an mourning ring of five pounds value

Item I give unto my above mentioned friend William Acrell all the remainder and residue of my estate be it of what kind soever

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my said friend William Acrell my Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & affixed my seal this twenty sixth day of January Anno Domini 1772
