have granted bargained and do sell and deliver and by these presents do give grant and
confirm unto Ann Hudson of the County and Parish aforesaid one negro girl called Sally
To have & to hold the said negro Sally of me the said W^m Hudson unto the said Ann
Hudson her heirs Executors Assigns and Assigns from hence forth to her and their
own proper use and uses thereof and there with to do & perform and dispose at her or their
wills and Pleasures and of their own proper goods and chattels, True and Peaceably
and Quietly without any manner of Lett Trouble or Denial of me the said W^m Hudson
or any other person or persons whatsoever of all which premises I the said W^m Hudson
have put the said Ann Hudson in full and Peaceable Possession by Virtue hereof
In Witness whereof I the said W^m Hudson have hereunto set my hand and seal
this fifth day of September Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & Eighty eight

Shortly intended to be solemnized between the said W^m Vaughan and Ann Dancy
Daughter of John Dancy of the said County & Parish aforesaid mentioned, do by these
presents give grant and Make over unto my said Son W^m Vaughan the following Slaves
to wit Jamey & Rob. two men, and Sucky a Negro Girl together with the future
Increase of the said Sucky to have and to hold the said Slaves and the increase
of the said female Slave Sucky unto the said W^m Vaughan his heirs and Assigns forever
I the said A. Rutley Vaughan do for my self my heirs Executors Assigns hereby forever Warrant
