own proper uses thence and there with to do Disposse and dispose at her or their
will and pleasure as of their own proper goods and chattels Free and Peaceably
and Quietly without any manner of Lett & trouble or denial of me the said W^m. Hudson
or any other person or persons whatsoever of all which premises The said W^m. Hudson
have paid the said Ann Hudson in full and Peaceable Disposition by Virtue hereof



shortly intended to be solemnized between the said W^m. Vaughan and Ann Dancy
Daughter of Mr Dancy of this said County & Parish aforesaid do by these
presentes give grant and make over unto my said Son W^m. Vaughan the following Slaves
to wit Dancy 40 Bob. two men, and Suky a Negro Girl together with the future
increase of the said Suky to have and to hold the said Slaves and the increase
of this said female Slave Suky unto the said W^m. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever
& I the said Challey Vaughan do for myself my heirs & assigns hereby for ever warrant
