make this my last Will and Testament, that is to say, first and
principally I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
gave it and my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named hoping through the Joyfull Redeemer and as touching my
Worldly Estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with
give and dispose in manner and form following my Will is that
Just debts and funeral charges be first paid

Imprimis first my Will and desire is that my son Thomas Spragins
have the use of my Negro Boy named Abram and after his Death, I
give said Negro boy unto my Grand son William Spragins and his
Heirs forever. — Item I give unto my son Thomas Spragins my
Saddle and bridle and a piece of Double wove Virginia cloth
Item I leave unto my son Thomas Spragins my bay Horse during his
natural life and after his decease I give the said Horse to my Grand
William Spragins, to him and his Heirs forever

Item I give unto beloved son William Spragins, three Negroes
Wench named Alley & young fellow named Adam and a boy
named Lewis to him and his Heirs forever — Item I give unto my
son William Spragins, my Gray Mare — Item I give unto my
Daughter Jane Richardson, one Negro Man named Dick to her
and her Heirs forever — Item I give unto my Grand daughter
Amy Griffith one Negro Boy named Frank, to her and her
Heirs forever — Item my will and desire is that my stock
of Cattle be equally divided between my two sons Tho: & Wm Spragins
to them and their Heirs forever and my will and desire is that all
the Remainder of my Estate both real and personal be equally
divided between my two sons Thomas and William Spragins,
to them and their Heirs forever I do hereby make constitute and Ordain
my son William Spragins my sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament Revoking and disannulling all others With & Testame
formerly by me and do publish and declare this to be my last Will &
Testament In Witness whereof I have set my Hand and seal the

At a Court held for Charles City County Wednesday the 2^d day of June
1773

The Aforewritten last Will and Testament of William Spragens deceased was in open Court proved by the oath of Hardyman & Dancy one of the Witnesses thereto and admitted to record and on the Motion of William Spragens, the Executor therein named, and making oath thereto according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form; he giving security Whereupon he together with Henry Southall and Hardyman Dancy his Securities entered into and Acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds current Money with Condition as the Law in this Case directs.

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Thompson my Negro boy named Mingo one feather Bed and furniture my Cotton and Wool Slaves & Harneis one book the whole Duty of Man and the sum of Forty five pounds current Money of Virginia to her and her Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Harmon Thompson all my wearing Apparel — I give and bequeath unto my son James Thompson my large Bible — I give and bequeath unto my son in law William Emory my Negro Woman Doll to him and his Heirs forever further my will and desire is that all the Rest of my Estate both Real and personal be sold and the Money arising therefrom after paying all my just Debts and Legacy to my Daughter Sarah Thompson be equally Divided amongst the rest of my Children to wit, Harmon, Mary, James, Elizabeth, Martha, Thomas, Ruth and George — I Constitute and appoint my Friends Thomas Ballars, Freeman Walker and James Bullisant my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Revoking and disannulling all other Wills that have been
