Anna Ladd of Charles City County being ill of Body but in
perfect sense ^{mind} and Memory do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form as followeth. I give and
bequeath unto John Crew son of John Crew sent my largest Feather
Bed with half the furniture belonging to Two, also the Two choice
Cows and Calves, and all my Pewter and Knives and Forks. Item
I give and bequeath unto Margaret Crew wife of Micajah Crew
my other feather Bed and furniture, and One looking Glass. Item
I give and bequeath to young Harrington Hamps One Horse a Cow and
Calf. Item I give and bequeath to my Brother William Ladd Two
Yearlings. Item I give and bequeath unto old Sall wife of old
Harrington Five pounds Cash, also my will is that young Hamps-
ton shall have half of all the crop that is now on the plantation
and the other half after my sister Sarah Crew is paid my Will
is that the above mentioned John Crew sent shall have the balance
thereof, And my Will and desire further is that all my Estate that
I have not given away be equally divided between all my Sisters. And
now I nominate apprentice

I give and bequeath to young Harrington Hamps One Horse a Cow and
Calf. Item I give and bequeath to my Brother William Ladd Two
Yearlings. Item I give and bequeath unto old Sall wife of old

ton shall have half of all the crop that is now on the plantation
and the other half after my sister Sarah Crew is paid my will
is that the above mentioned John Crew junr shall have the balance
thereof, And my Will and desire further is that all my Estate that
I have not given away be equally divided between all my Sisters. And
now I nominate appoint and ordain John Crew junr Executor of
this my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have
set my hand and seal this eighth day of the seventh Month One
thousand seven hundred and Ninetyone.

At a Monthly Court held for Charles City County at the Courthouse on Thursday
the Nineteenth day of January 1792.

The aforewritten last Will and Testament of Anna Lide deceased was presented
into Court and proved by the Affirmations of John Crew sen^r and Samuel
Hargrave the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion
of John Crew jun^r the Executor therein named who Affirmed according to
Law and together with John Crew sen^r ^{his security} entered into and acknowledged their
Bond in the penalty of Two hundred pounds conditioned as the Law directs
probat in granted him in due form.
