Wills

In the name of God amen. I Ann Shields Minge of the County
of Charles City and parish of Westover do make and ordain this my
last will and testament in manner and form following to wit.

First of all I give unto my dear sister Elizabeth Collier Harrison daugh-
ter of Collie and Christiana Harrison all the money due me from my
father's estate and all my best clothes to her and her heirs forever.

Item. my common clothes I desire shoule be given to such of the negroes
as my dear Mamona shoule think proper.

Item I give unto my nieces Lucy Dandridge and Christiana Dandridge
each a memorial of my hair to be furnished them by my executors
to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give unto my dear sister Judith Minge my dear Papa's —
picture to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I desire that all my negroes that were left me by my dear Papa
should together with their present and future increase, to be liberated after
my death by my executors hereafter named.

Item. I desire that out of the money I have left my dear sister Elizabeth
C. Harrison be paid annually the sum of eight pounds unto my old
nurse Kate so long as she may live & I hope that all my friends will take
care of her and not let her suffer in her old age for my sake.

Item. I desire that in case of Elizabeth C. Harrison's death that the whole
property I have left her may be divided between Lucy and Christiana —
Dandridge to be theirs and their increase forever.

Item. But in case of the death of either the above two nieces the surviving
one to heir her portion.

Item. I desire that the reverend Jewell Chapman should preach my funeral
Sermon, if he is a resident of this county at my death, otherwise I desire

that the reverend James Neumann should perform the ceremony and a liberal fee be given to the minister, as also the negro which bears me to the grave be rewarded.

Lastly I do constitute and appoint my dear Papa Collin Harrison John Minge and George W. H. Minge my executors of this my last Will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight.

At a Quarterly Court held for Charles City County at the Court House on Thursday the twentieth of March 1808. The before written last Will and testament of Ann, Shields, Minge was proved by the oaths of George Minge and Benjamin Cocke two of the witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of John Minge one of the executors therein named, who made ~~estate~~ as the law directs, and together with Hamlin Willcox and George Minge his securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the sum of five thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat in due form Collin Harrison and George Minge two of the executors therein named refused to take upon themselves the burthen and execution thereof.

I Samuel Dorsey of the County of Charles City and parish of Westover being in a weak state of bodily health, but in perfect mind sound sense and memory thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body, knowing it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and ordain this to be my last Will and testament in manner and form following.

First. I recommend my body to the earth, and my soul to the hands of the Almighty God in hopes of a glorious resurrection, and as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with I dispose of as follows.

Herr. I desire that all bonds and demands that I have against my two brothers to wit Goodrich and Cornelius Dorsey should be given up to them on application
