Secondly I Give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Frances Ann Binford and Judith Garthright all the Real and Personal of my Estate both real and Personal that is to say Land and negroes and every other species of property that I may be possessed of to be equally divided between them and their Heirs lawfully begotten of their bodies forever except my Right in the Sill that I give and bequeath unto Robert Binford to him and his Heirs forever. Lastly I do appoint Robert Binford William Bates and Selding Holland Executors to this my last Will and Testament to see the same duly performed. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty six day of June Anno Domini one thousand Eight hundred and Six
