At a Monthly Court held for Charles City County at the Courthouse on Thursday the nineteenth day of June 1800. The aforementioned last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Spraggins dec'd. was proved by John Nance j^r a witness thereto and ordered to be

recorded and on the motion of John Vance senior one of the executors therein named who made oath as the law directs and together with Edward Walker and Stephen Shell his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form. The other executor named in the said Will by his letter to the Court refused to join the Probate.

The Common Council of Virginia to Thomas G Peasley William Pintas and Elias Parker Magistrates of the town of Petersburg greeting Whereas William Scott and Sarah his wife of the County of Dinwiddie of their certain Indenture of bargain and sale bearing date the 15 day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety five have sold and conveyed unto Samuel Allen one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Charles City containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less and whereas the said Sarah cannot conveniently travel to the Court of the said County to make acknowledgment of the said conveyance Therefore to you or any two or more of you is given full power and authority to receive the acknowledgment which the said Sarah shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid and to return in the Indenture aforesaid her command and you or any two or more of you that you go to the said Sarah and take her acknowledgment of the same and examine her privately and apart from her said husband and whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of him her said husband and whether she is willing the same shall be recorded in the County aforesaid And when you have received the same and examined her as aforesaid that you certify the same acknowledgment distinctly and openly in the said Court sending and returning at the same time this writ Witness Otho Byrd Clerk of the said Court the fifteenth day of August 1795 and the twentieth year of the Commonwealth.
