

Henry Lacy of Charles City County being sick but of sound sense and memory do make this my last will & testament revoking all others by me heretofore made in Manner and form as follows - ^{Wife} I desire that all my just debts should be paid out of my estate - I lend unto my beloved wife Lucy all my estate during her widowhood to enable her to bring up & educate my children not doubting but that she will act the part of a kind and affectionate Mother - But should my wife Lucy Marry my will & desire is that all my estate should be divided between my children or their heirs. I appoint my friend Benson Hopkins my executor & my wife my executrix to this my will & desire that she my said wife should give no security for the performance of her duty as executrix - Signed with my own hand this 28th of November 1807.
