In the name of God AMEN. I Elizabeth Carter of the Parish of Westover and the County of Charles City, being in sound mind and memory, doth make this my last Will and Testament, and doth give and bequeath all my estate in manner and form following to wit. —— Item. I give to my daughter Sarah Holt one pound five shillings to her and her heirs forever. Item, I give to Miss Ann Gregory daughter to my Grandson Samuel Gregory my best Bed and furniture, Two choice Pows and Calves, Two Pewter dishes a half Dozen Pewter Plates and a copper Tea Kettle, to her and her heirs forever. Item, I give to my Grandson Saml. Gregory one Negro Boy Sam. and all the residue of my estate whatever it may be, to him and his heirs for ever. I doth constitute and appoint Samuel Gregory my Executor to this my last Will and Testament. It is my Will and desire, that there should be no Inventory and appraisement of my estate. Given under my hand and seal this Ninth day of February 1791.
