In the name of God Amen I John Iley of the County of Charles City being very sick and weak but
in my perfect senses do make this my last will and testament in Manner and form following Vizt
It is my will and desire that my land may be sold for the payment of all my just debts with
a reservation of one acre of ground for the purpose of a burying ground - It is my will and desire
that my wife Elizabeth Iley shall have all the rest of my estate of every kind during her life,
and at her death that she may have the power of dividing it among my children as she may
think proper - I do appoint my wife Elizabeth Iley and John Royall senr. Executors to this my
last will and testament given under my hand and seal this 5th of December 1807.
