I beg leave respectfully to observe and report, that the third and fifth items debited to the estate I admitted, because I thought them reasonable; That all the other items of charge were supported by vouchers as per statements here made. And that a balance of two hundred and one pounds sixteen shillings and three farthings having remained in the hands of the Committee, ~~since~~ since the first day of August 1799.
