Notice being personally given by me to John Edloe Jr one of the heirs of John Edloe deceased and who said he was the legally authorized agent of the other two, of the time when and place where I should settle the transactions of the Committee of his Father estate and he having personally attested to me in obedience to an order of the worshipful court of this County directed to me, to examine, state and settle the transactions of William Royall late high sheriff &c on the estate of John Edloe deceased a copy of which order is hereunto annexed. I beg leave respectfully to observe and report, that the third and fifth items debited to the estate I admitted, because I thought them reasonable; That all the other items of charge were supported by vouchers as per statement here made. And that a balance of two hundred and one pounds sixteen shillings and three farthings having remained in the hands of the Committee since the first day of August 1799. I deem it reasonable that legal interest be allowed thereon from the said first day of August, until the day of its disbursement. Given under my hand the day and year first above written.
