Inquisition Indented taken at Joseph Christians Landing in the County aforesaid the sixth day of January in the year eighteen hundred and two before me William Graves one of the Clerks of the Commonwealth of Virginia for the County aforesaid upon the View of the body of Robert Gordon Mauner then and there lying Dead and upon oaths of William Southall, Edward Holdcroft, William Holdsworth, Bernskin Hopkins, Jones Finch, Thomas Blanks, John E. Bailey, Joseph Christian, Henry Phillips, Charles Burns, John Blanks, and Wyatt Walker, good and Lawfull men of the said County, who being sworn and Charged to Enquire on the part of the Commonwealth when, where, how, and in what manner the said Robert Gordon came to his death do say upon their oath, that the said Gordon being on board a Vessel in Chickahomany River by Casualty and Misfortune fell overboard from the vessel in the Waters of the River aforesaid and then Instantly got drowned and so the

Jurors. aforesaid upon their Oath aforesaid say that the aforesaid Jordan in  
Manner and form aforesaid then and there became by his Death. In Witness  
whereof aswell the aforesaid Coroner as the Jurors aforesaid have to this In-  
-question put their hands and seals on the day and year aforesaid, at the place
