 and memory, doth make this my last Will and Testament, and doth
 give and bequeath all my estate in manner and foron following
 to wit. — " — " Item, I give to my daughter Sarah Holt one pound
 five shillings to her and her heirs forever. Item, I give to Miss Ann
 Gregory daughter to my Grandson Samuel Gregory my best Bed
 and furniture, Two choice hogs and calves, Two pewter dishes a half
 dozen pewter plates and a copper Tea Kettle, to her and her heirs
 forever. Item, I give to my Grandson Saml Gregory one Negroe Boy
 Sam. and all the residue of my estate: whatever it may be, to him

 Gregory my Executor to this my last Will and Testament. It is my
