This is my will and desire that my land may be sold for the payment of all my just debts; with a reservation of one acre of ground for the purpose of a burying ground. It is my will and desire that my wife Elizabeth Iby shall have all the rest of my estate of every kind during her life, and at her death that she may have the power of dividing it among my children as she may think proper. I do appoint my wife Elizabeth Iby and John Roysell executors to this my last will and testament given under my hand and seal this 3^d of December 1807.
