In the name of God Amen I John Deby of the County of Charles City being very sick and weak but in my perfect senses do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following. It is my will and desire that my land may be sold for the payment of all my just debts; with a reservation of one acre of ground for the purpose of a burying ground. It is my will and desire that my wife Elizabeth Deby shall have all the rest of my estate of every kind during her life, and at her death that she may have the power of dividing it among my children as she may think proper. I do appoint my wife Elizabeth Deby and John Royall sons Executrix to this my last will and testament given under my hand and seal this 3^d of December 1807
