I Give to Charles Evans my near relation all my lands & plantations which I now do hold except one Acre including the House where she now lives I leave to the use of Grace Phillis Evans as long as she may remain single with lands to support it And then that with all the rest and remainder of my Estate I Give to Charles Evans to have and to hold to him and his heirs for Ever.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my Brother Charles Evans Executor of this my last Will and testament hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore by me made In witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 11th of the 11 month 1806
