Conformable to an order of Charles City County Court we the under written subscribers Commissioners appointed by the said Court, hath allotted unto Lucy Bradley who was Widow of Samuel Waddill deceased her dower in the Slaves of said Waddill estate to wit: to the said Lucy Bradley a Negro boy (Moses) being in value equal to one third of the aforesaid Slaves. the order of Court farther directed we should also lay off a dower in the land of Samuel Waddill however by consent of parties we were directed not to do so given under our hands in the year 1796
